The Powder Magazine, a National Historic Landmark, is owned and operated by The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America in The State of South Carolina. The building, completed in 1713, is one of the two surviving fortified structures of its kind in what were the Thirteen Original Colonies. It is the oldest public building in the Carolinas, if not in all the former British colonies, and is one of the few remaining surviving military structures associated with the siege and capture of Charleston by the British in 1780.

All campers receive an official Patriots Point Camping souvenir patch!

- Campers must be at least six years old; One chaperone for every ten campers is required. Chaperones must be parents or responsible adults. We only have been allotted 5 slots available for female participants and one must be an adult so it will be based on first to complete registration.
- Patriots Point does not allow visitors and campers to bring aboard outside food and drink. A snack bar and vending machines are available in addition to scheduled meals.
- Each person must bring a sleeping bag, pillow, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, soap, towel, wash cloth and all other necessary personal effects. Insect repellent is advisable.
- Berthing areas are separated by gender, without exception. Female leaders must be responsible for female participants and male leaders for male participants.
- The berthing quarters are heated and air conditioned. Shower stalls are located in the restroom facilities adjacent to all berthing quarters.
- The State Fire Marshall requires all campers participate in a brief fire drill. All campers must be on board YORKTOWN by 8:30 p.m., without exception.

Each overnight stay at Patriots Point includes an excursion option to another one of the Charleston area's great educational attractions. Because of availability limitations, you'll be asked to make a first, second and third excursion choice when registering. 1<sup>st</sup> Choice: **The Powder Magazine**; 2<sup>nd</sup> Choice: **Tour of Ft. Sumter**; 3<sup>rd</sup> Choice: **Charleston Explorer**
